## DIRECTIONS TO LAVENDER HOUSE FROM THE SOUTH On the A36 Via Warminster.

Approaching Bath, at the Beckford Road junction, the A36 becomes the ring road around the south of the City. Turn left here at the traffic lights following signs for BRISTOL A36 (A4) and WELLS (A39). Remain on the A36 for about

1 mile, passing straight ahead at a roundabout and one set of traffic lights beneath an iron railway bridge and following the road as it divides into dual carriageway before reaching the Churchill Bridge roundabout and railway viaduct. At this roundabout take the first exit signposted SHEPTON MALLET (A37) and RADSTOCK A367. After turning left, continue uphill until reaching a right hand bend in the road (look out for "The Bear" Pub on your right after the bend).

Continue on for about 150 yards then, at the telephone box, take the right fork signposted Bloomfield Road.

Bloomfield Park is the second turning on the right opposite St. Luke's Church.

Lavender House is a little way along on the left hand side opposite the red post box.

ALTERNATIVE DIRECTIONS – leaving the A36 about 10 miles south of Bath, avoiding Bath City ring road and passing through Norton St. Philip, Hinton Charterhouse and Midford.

About 20 miles further on from the junction of the A36 and A303, and having passed around Warminster, take the left fork at Woolverton onto the B3110 for Norton St. Philip, Hinton Charterhouse and Midford.

After Midford the road climbs steeply for 1 mile and is then level for another half a mile before reaching a crossroads. This is a junction having two mini roundabouts and with an Esso filling station / Tesco Express on the left. Turn left here following signs for Bristol (A4) and Crematorium, pass straight ahead at the next roundabout and

turn right at the traffic lights about 200 yards further on. This is Bloomfield Road. Go downhill for about three quarters of a mile looking out for Castle Gardens on the right and then Englishcombe Lane on the left. Bloomfield Park is the next turning on the left.

Lavender House is a little way along on the left hand side opposite the red post box.
